Then put the Tenant Number which is the last 2 digits (i.e. 98). Your account number can be found on your printed Bill. Lastly, add the alias in the bottom field which is any name that will help you identify the account. Your Service Address is best if you are not sure what to use (i.e. 56 Allister Lane). Once finished, click "Submit". If you have more than one service address that you would like to link, add next account's info. If all finished, click "Cancel".
